## SCULPTURE SUBMISSIONS

### INTERIOR

Small to medium sized sculpture for exhibition in shop windows and must be displayed on an independent white plinth (supplied by artist). Remember our shop window sizes do vary and the sculptures will share window space with shops merchandise.

### EXTERIOR

Large sized recent sculpture, extremely robust and able to be fixed/bolted to a temporary concrete plinth (70x70x30cm) on footpath for installation along Toorak Road. There will be 5 sites available. Sculpture height – under 3m, width and depth 60cm or less.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- All sculpture submissions must be made in Australia, original, recent and safe for public display.
- Artist is responsible for supplying a white plinth to exhibit interior work on, size depends on window space so wait for allocated shop before making or investing in a plinth. We can assist some interstate entries with the use of our plinths if selected, but these are limited.
- Delivery, installation and removal of work is the responsibility of the artist.

- Sculptures must remain on display for the duration of the exhibition – any artist removing work early without exhibition coordinators permission will be unable to exhibit again in the future.
- Artist is responsible for own insurance.
- All sculptures must be available for sale. The Toorak Village Traders Association deducts a commission of 33% for all sales made throughout the Toorak Village Sculpture Exhibition.
- There is a \$40 artist fee – per artist, to assist with administration costs.
- A curator and selection panel will determine successful entries and businesses will be consulted for approval of sculpture displayed in their window.
- Details of site/shop will be emailed – it is advised artists visit shop to determine space, size of plinth, power if needed and to make contact with business owner for easy installation. Interstate artists please discuss with exhibition coordinator. Please remember our businesses are giving up their valuable window space for 6-weeks to accommodate sculptures – any problems please call our exhibition coordinator.
- Artists of larger exterior submissions will be contacted by curator to discuss position and installation details. Ben Fasham will assist with installation of all exterior sculptures.
- 3 cash prizes of \$10,000, \$3,000 and \$2,000 will be awarded at the Opening Night event, date to be confirmed. Invitations will be emailed to all exhibiting artists.
- We will provide all signage, price tickets and marketing.
